This activity comes from a website called Kidscraftroom.com and is a way of making a walking ant puppet. You need thin card, glue, a lollipop stick and some wiggly eyes (optional). <https://youtu.be/ZvOwmR-3S8c>

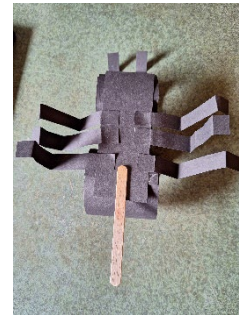
Cut four rectangles of card. Make one small, two medium and one large. Roll the small one into a tight roll, one medium into a bit bigger roll and the large into a larger roll. These are the three parts of your ant – the small one is its thorax or chest, the medium one is its head and the big one is its abdomen or bottom. Glue them onto the other medium rectangle of card and glue the lollipop stick underneath to form a handle you can hold to make your ant move.

Cut two antennae out of card and stick them on the head, together with wiggly eyes (or you could draw eyes) and a drawn mouth. Cut six legs out of card, bend them like in the illustration, and glue them onto the inside of the middle roll. Now you have an ant. As you play with it, ask God to make you wise too.

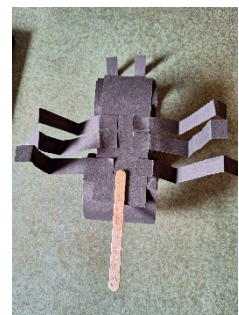
Cut four rectangles of card. Make one small, two medium and one large. Roll the small one into a tight roll, one medium into a bit bigger roll and the large into a larger roll.
